Council President Small: Mr. Bujalski.

Deputy Director of Health, Phil Bujalski: Yes good evening. Phil Bujalski Deputy Health Director for the town covering this evening for Director Dennis Green. Pleased to report that the state county and Woodbridge Township infection numbers and fatalities have steadily been decreasing to their lowest level since the start of this pandemic. This afternoon the Woodbridge Health Department held our 64th COVID vaccination clinic. To date we have administered a total of 9,630 vaccinations and have fully vaccinated 4,788 persons; the substantial amount of those have been Woodbridge Township residents. We have seen a steady flow of walk-ins which is very promising. Our last two clinics the walk-ins represented 25-50% of the persons being vaccinated. We are awaiting approval from the U.S. Food & Drug Administration for adolescent Moderna so that those between 12 and 18 years of age who want to be vaccinated can do so. We'll continue to have clinics scheduled throughout the summer and we will continue to have those clinics as you the Board and Administration see fit to continue. Thank you, thank you for your support serving as the Board and our Administrations supports us very well, I'll convey that thanks to them.

Council President Small: Thank you. Mr. Bujalski we always tell Director Green but we'll tell you too, the Council and Administration can't be happier with the job that the Health Department did during this horrific Pandemic so again great job and please pass it on to everyone else.

On a motion made by Councilman Bauer seconded by Councilman Spillar and carried unanimously, Council President Small adjourned the meeting at 6:50 P.M.
