



We are very pleased to have you as a participating vendor at BarronFest 2020. Once again, the event is scheduled for **Saturday, October 10th, 2020** in Woodbridge's Alvin P. Williams Memorial Park. **(See below for inclement weather information.)** Enclosed, please find 2 BarronFest promotional posters to display in your neighborhood or place of business. Also, please feel free to post and share BarronFest 2020 on social media!

Here is a list of vendor guidelines to make the day run as smoothly as possible.

- If you need to cancel your participation at BarronFest 2020, please do so as early as possible by calling 732-634-0413 (dial 0 for the operator) or emailing us at BARRONFEST@twp.woodbridge.nj.us
- Please make every effort to attend BarronFest. We always like a full house and that benefits us all!
- Alvin P. Williams Park is located at 529 Cliff Road in Sewaren, Woodbridge Township, NJ 07077
- Once again, each artist will be assigned approximately 12'x12' of free space.
- Tables, chairs, easels, tents & set-up materials are the vendors responsibility. The Barron Arts Center will NOT supply these items.
- Vendor set-up time begins at 10:30am. If need be, vendors may drive vehicles into the festival area to unload. There is one road in and out of the park. We will post signage and banners to help navigate vendors to the festival area. Please unpack and move your vehicles out of the festival area as quickly and carefully as possible to ensure that the event set-up runs smoothly. Please be mindful of other vendors and steer clear of neighboring spaces as you unload.
- Ample vendor parking will be available at the spacious lot at Alvin P. Williams Memorial Park.
- Artists are encouraged to demonstrate their art/craft during the exhibition. Demonstrations must be contained within the space assigned.
- BarronFest is scheduled for 12noon-4:30pm. Please respect these times and stay until the end of the festival.
- INCLEMENT WEATHER INFO:** BarronFest 2020 is a RAIN-OR-SHINE EVENT. It is up to the vendor if they want to set up or not due to weather concerns. This is a no-charge event for vendors. In the event of dangerous weather conditions, vendors will be notified of a full cancellation of the event by 1pm Friday, October 9th (the day before the event).

COVID-19 Guidelines

As we begin our slow return to normalcy, it is important that we do not forget the simple measures we can take to prevent sickness for ourselves and for others.

We will be following all CDC & State guidelines pertaining to outdoor gatherings. These guidelines are in constant flux, so we will keep you up to date in the days leading up to BarronFest 2020.

Due to the recent health crisis we will be limiting the number of vendors allowed to participate in BarronFest 2020 to no more than 45 approved artist/crafters.

We will also be spacing vendors further away from each other than we normally would to help limit person-to-person exposure.

Hand washing stations will be placed throughout the festival area. However, Alvin P. Williams Park has large and well maintained restroom facilities.


We will be kindly enforcing social distancing and encouraging facemasks whenever possible.




