This is Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac and today is Friday, September 25.

The Township had an up and down week with 11 new cases of Coronavirus on Monday, three on Tuesday, seven on Wednesday and three on Thursday. Over half of the 24 new cases are part of larger groups from prior days and weeks but they are from private gatherings and not any public locations.

There were no new cases in outside facilities and thankfully no new deaths to report.

Please keep up with social distancing and mask wearing and honoring limits on gatherings and always check on your neighbors.

The Drop Box outside of Town Hall is officially open now so you can start dropping off your general election ballots once they are completed. If you drop it tomorrow from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM stick around for our weekly Farmer's Market in the Town Hall parking lot.

Tomorrow is National Public Lands Day and park cleanups will be happening all over town. Sunday morning is our annual Bike Tour leaving from the Woodbridge Community Center beginning at 8:00 AM with check-in starting at 7:00 AM.

The Census 2020 deadline has been moved back to October 30. There is an opportunity to register in person for the Census this Saturday and Sunday at Curtains Restaurant at the Avenel Performing Center from 11:00 AM – 4:00 PM. It is vitally important that all Woodbridge residents be counted to maximize the Federal Aid that not only the Township but also our community and faith-based organizations receive.

Garage sales and yard sales will be happening all over Fords, Hopelawn, Keasbey and Menlo Park Terrace this weekend. Permits are fee and you can register your house on the Township web site and also check for specific sales or just drive around and look.
