Dear Woodbridge Township Resident:

In the aftermath of Super Storm Sandy, Woodbridge Township businesses, residents, and concerned citizens contributed funds to assist fellow residents and victims who may have unmet needs as a result of Super Storm Sandy.

The Township entered into an agreement with the United Way of Central Jersey on behalf of the Middlesex County Long Term Recovery Group (MCLTRG) in order to make distribution of the limited funds available via the Woodbridge Community Charity Fund to those Woodbridge Township victims with remaining unmet needs. The MCLTRG is a voluntary association representing numerous entities involved in post-Super Storm Sandy relief, recovery, rebuilding, and community development efforts and, as such, the MCLTRG has implemented an application process to determine unmet needs and to allot funds for those victims eligible for additional financial assistance for unmet needs.

We would encourage any Woodbridge Township resident flood victim with unmet needs to contact the MCLTRG and to apply for funds from the Woodbridge Community Charity Fund, as well as for any/all programs managed by the MCLTRG – the MCLTRG may be able to provide assistance over and above Woodbridge Township assistance. We have enclosed information on how to contact the MCLTRG to assist in the application process.

While no federal or state funding has yet been allocated for a home “buy-out” program in Woodbridge, we are closely monitoring developments regarding funding allocation for any program that may benefit Township residents. We would again encourage any resident flood victim whose home was damaged or destroyed by Super Storm Sandy and who wishes to be considered for possible home “buy-out” through the State of New Jersey Blue Acres program, to file a Blue Acres application with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) as soon as possible. You can download the Blue Acres application via the Woodbridge Township web page at: www.twp.woodbridge.nj.us (click on the FEMA information link and go to the Blue Acres Program Application.)

Additionally, the Governor’s Office of Rebuilding & Recovery (GORR) recently announced the availability of funding for eligible homeowners to repair, elevate or rebuild their primary residences in affected communities (Woodbridge residents may be eligible for rebuilding grants). Woodbridge Township homeowners should apply via www.sandyhelp.nj.gov.

We will keep you informed.
