This is Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac and today is Friday, January 22.

The Township had 162 new cases of Coronavirus from the general public in the last three days with 60 on Tuesday, 62 on Wednesday and 40 on Thursday. Who would have thought that 40 new cases in one day would be welcome news? All of our averages are dropping and we hope and pray that this trend continues.

There were no new cases in State or health care facilities but we unfortunately have three new deaths to report of three males aged 97, 67 and believe it or not 36. Please keep each of these victims and their families in your thoughts and prayers.

We will keep reminding you to practice good personal hygiene and wear masks and be socially distant from others. All of the limits on inside and outside gatherings are listed on our Township web site along with other guidelines from the State related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Township is continuing to vaccinate people at the Woodbridge Health Center but we have no control over who gets scheduled. People who receive confirmation from the State Department of Health that they are in the system should periodically check the State web site to see what is available and sign-up as soon as you can.

Our Senior Center employees have helped over 500 seniors register and if other seniors or anyone else needs help with that please call: 732-726-6264. Please remember that we cannot advise you on whether or not to get the vaccine or answer questions related to your medical conditions.
