

Disaster Recovery Centers (DRC) are accessible facilities and mobile offices set up after a disaster. DRCs are placed in or near affected communities, in an area that offers equal access and resources to everyone.

You may visit a DRC to –

- Learn about disaster assistance programs.
- Apply for disaster assistance.
- Check the status of your FEMA application.
- Help you understand FEMA notices or letters.
- Find housing and rental assistance information.
- Get referrals to agencies that offer other assistance.
- Meet with a Small Business Administration (SBA) agent.
