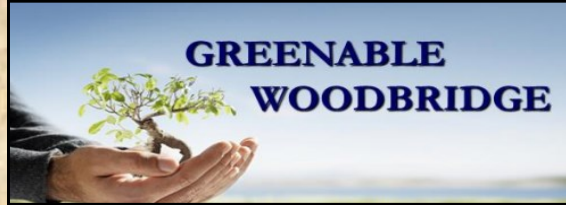

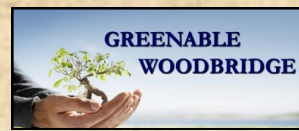

It Pays to Plug In: NJ's Electric Vehicle Workplace Charging Grant Program provides grants to employers to offset the cost of purchasing and installing electric vehicle charging stations.

Upon completion of work in accordance with the eligibility criteria, N.J. DEP will reimburse each applicant as follows: up to \$250 per Level 1 charging station and up to \$5,000 per Level 2 charging station.
