**WOODBRIIDGE** – Mayor John E. McCormac and Paul J. Sansone, Sr., Chairman of the Board of Motors Management Corp. and The Sansone Dealer Group, today announced the award of a \$250,000.00 grant which will fund the Woodbridge Military Assistance Center – an outreach program in place to assist Woodbridge-area Veterans.
